Key Points

There is one God (Deuteronomy 6:4, Isaiah 44:6)

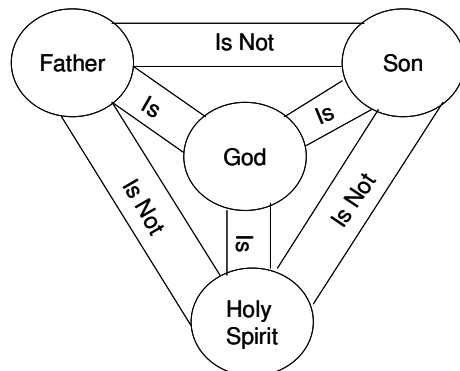
The truth that there is only one God is important throughout the Bible. God taught this to his people Israel and this belief made them different from the other nations around them. The New Testament writings again confirm this truth.

The one God is in three Persons (Genesis 1:26, Matthew 28:19)

Even though there is the unity of one God, this God is in three persons:

- The **Father** is God (1 Corinthians 8:6)
- The **Son** is God (Hebrews 1:8)
- The **Holy Spirit** is God (Acts 5, 3-4)

The Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit are distinct persons (John 14:16)
